## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the investigation of fire fighters employed by certain 3 municipalities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended 5 by adding Section 180.008 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 180.008. INVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN FIRE FIGHTERS REQUIRED. (a) In this section: 8 (1) "Fire fighter" means a paid employee of a 9 municipal fire department who: 10 (A) holds a position that requires substantial 11 12 knowledge of fire fighting; 13 (B) has met the requirements for certification by 14 the Texas Commission on Fire Protection under Chapter 419, Government Code; and 15 16 (C) performs a function listed in Section 143.003(4)(A). 17 18 (2) "Investigation" means an administrative investigation, conducted by a municipality, of alleged misconduct 19 by a fire fighter that could result in punitive action against the 20 21 fire fighter. 22 (3) "Punitive action" has the meaning assigned by 23 Section 143.312. 24 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (d), Section 143.312

1	applies to the investigation of a fire fighter conducted by a
2	municipality, other than a municipality to which Section 143.123
3	applies. For a municipality to which Chapter 143 does not apply, a
4	violation of Section 143.312 may be considered as provided by
5	Section 143.312(1) by the appropriate authority during any
6	disciplinary appeal hearing provided by the municipality.
7	(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a municipality to
8	which Subsection (b) applies may not take punitive action against a
9	fire fighter unless an investigation has been conducted in
10	substantial compliance with Section 143.312.
11	(d) This section does not apply to the investigation of a
12	fire fighter that directly relates to the facts and circumstances
13	of an offense for which the fire fighter has been convicted that:
14	(1) involves family violence, as defined by Section
15	71.004, Family Code; and
16	(2) is punishable as a felony or Class A or Class B
17	misdemeanor.
18	(e) To the extent that Subchapter B, Chapter 614, Government
19	Code, applies and conflicts with this section, this section
20	<u>controls.</u>
21	SECTION 2. Section 180.008, Local Government Code, as added
22	by this Act, applies only to an investigation of a fire fighter, as
23	those terms are defined by that section, initiated by a
24	municipality on or after the effective date of this Act.
25	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
