4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 180.008 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 180.008. INVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN FIRE FIGHTERS. (a)
8	In this section:
9	(1) "Emergency services district" means an emergency
10	services district created under Chapter 775, Health and Safety
11	Code.
12	(2) "Fire fighter" means a paid employee of a
13	municipal fire department or emergency services district who:
14	(A) holds a position that requires substantial
15	knowledge of fire fighting;
16	(B) has met the requirements for certification by
17	the Texas Commission on Fire Protection under Chapter 419,
18	Government Code; and
19	(C) performs a function listed in Section
20	143.003(4)(A).
21	(3) "Investigation" means an administrative
22	investigation, conducted by a municipality or an emergency services

district, of alleged misconduct by a fire fighter that could result

in punitive action against the fire fighter.

- 1 (4) "Punitive action" has the meaning assigned by 2 Section 143.312.
- 3 (b) Except as provided by this subsection, Section 143.312
- 4 applies to the investigation of a fire fighter conducted by a
- 5 municipality. This subsection does not apply to a municipality to
- 6 which Section 143.123 applies. For a municipality to which Chapter
- 7 143 does not apply, a violation of Section 143.312 may be considered
- 8 as provided by Section 143.312(1) by the appropriate authority
- 9 during any disciplinary appeal hearing provided by the
- 10 municipality.
- 11 (c) Section 143.312 applies to the investigation of a fire
- 12 fighter conducted by an emergency services district. For purposes
- 13 of this subsection, a reference to a municipality or a municipal
- 14 department head in Section 143.312 is considered to be a reference
- 15 to the district or the official of the district responsible for the
- 16 performance of the duty to which the provision applies. For
- 17 purposes of Section 143.312(1), a violation of Section 143.312 may
- 18 be considered as provided by Section 143.312(1) by the appropriate
- 19 authority during any disciplinary appeal hearing provided by the
- 20 district.
- 21 (d) To the extent that Subchapter B, Chapter 614, Government
- 22 Code, applies and conflicts with this section, this section
- 23 <u>controls.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 180.008, Local Government Code, as added
- 25 by this Act, applies only to an investigation of a fire fighter, as
- 26 those terms are defined by that section, initiated by a
- 27 municipality or emergency services district on or after the

- 1 effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
