- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 801.102(a), Government Code, is amended 4
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The board is composed of nine [seven] members.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 801.103, Government Code, is amended to
- read as follows: 8
- Sec. 801.103. MEMBERS APPOINTED BY GOVERNOR. 9 (a) The
- governor shall appoint, with the advice and consent of the senate, 10
- 11 [seven] members to the board.
- 12 (b) The governor shall appoint to the board:
- 13 (1) three persons who have experience in the fields of
- 14 securities investment, pension administration, or pension law but
- who are not members or retirees of a public retirement system; 15
- (2) one person who is a fellow of the Society of 16
- Actuaries, a member of the American Academy of Actuaries, or an 17
- enrolled actuary under the federal Employee Retirement Income 18
- Security Act of 1974 (29 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 et seq.); 19
- 20 (3) one person who has experience in the field of
- 21 governmental finance;
- (4) one person who is a contributing member of a public 22
- 23 retirement system; [and]
- 24 (5) one person who is receiving retirement benefits

- 1 from a public retirement system;
- 2 (6) one person who is selected from a list of three
- 3 names submitted to the governor by the Texas State Association of
- 4 Fire Fighters; and
- 5 (7) one person who is selected from a list of six names
- 6 submitted to the governor as follows:
- 7 (A) a list of three names submitted by the Texas
- 8 Municipal Police Association; and
- 9 (B) a list of three names submitted by the
- 10 Combined Law Enforcement Associations of Texas.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 801.106, Government Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 801.106. TERMS OF OFFICE. Members of the board hold
- 14 office for staggered terms of six years, with the terms of [two or]
- 15 three members $[\frac{1}{7}$ as appropriate $\frac{1}{7}$] expiring on January 31 of each
- 16 odd-numbered year.
- 17 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 18 of this Act, the governor shall appoint the two additional members
- 19 to the State Pension Review Board from lists provided to the
- 20 governor as required by Section 801.103, Government Code, as
- 21 amended by this Act. Notwithstanding Section 801.106, Government
- 22 Code, as amended by this Act, the members appointed under this
- 23 section serve terms expiring January 31, 2023.
- 24 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
