4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Title 5, Insurance Code, is amended by adding
6	Subtitle H to read as follows:
7	SUBTITLE H. CIVIL ACTIONS AGAINST REGULATED ENTITIES
8	CHAPTER 761. DAMAGES IN CERTAIN CIVIL ACTIONS
9	Sec. 761.001. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter
10	applies to each entity regulated by the commissioner, including an
11	entity listed in Section 802.051.
12	Sec. 761.002. DAMAGES IN CERTAIN CIVIL ACTIONS. In
13	addition to any other damages, including exemplary damages, costs,
14	and fees awarded, a court shall award to a claimant who prevails in
15	a civil action against an entity described by Section 761.001
16	arising from a claim for coverage or benefits under an insurance
17	policy or contract or health benefit plan that is written by the
18	entity exemplary damages in an amount equal to the total amount of
19	premiums, contributions, or other consideration paid by the
20	claimant under the policy, contract, or plan in the five years
21	preceding the date of judgment.
22	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
23	to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
24	this Act. A cause of action that accrued before the effective date

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- 1 of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the cause of action
- 2 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 3 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
