H.B. No. 2405

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the allocation of low income housing tax credits to 3 developments in certain areas designated as rural. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 2306.6740, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 2306.6740. DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN AREAS AS RURAL. 7 (a) The department by rule shall: 8 (1) provide for the designation by the department of 9 an area located within the boundaries of a primary metropolitan 10 11 statistical area or a metropolitan statistical area as a rural area under Section 2306.6702(a)(12)(B) for purposes of receiving 12 housing tax credits administered by the department under this 13 14 subchapter; and (2) designate the site of a proposed or existing 15 16 development as a rural area under Section 2306.6702(a)(12)(B) for purposes of receiving housing tax credits allocated by the 17 department under Sections 2306.111(d-2) and (d-3) if the 18 development, before September 1, 2013, has been awarded or has 19 received financial assistance under Section 514, 515, or 516 of the 20 Housing Act of 1949 (42 U.S.C. Section 1484, 1485, or 1486). 21 (b) Rules adopted under this section must: 22 23 (1) provide procedures by which a political 24 subdivision or a census-designated place may apply for a rural

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1 designation under Subsection (a)(1);

2 (2) provide guidelines for designating an area as
3 rural <u>under Subsection (a)(1)</u>, including specifying:

4 (A) conditions under which a rural designation is
5 not appropriate, including the proximity of the area to or the
6 presence of major amenities commonly associated with urban or
7 suburban areas; and

8 (B) conditions under which a rural designation is 9 appropriate, including areas with low population density, the 10 proximity of the area to or the absence of major amenities commonly 11 associated with urban or suburban areas, a high level of 12 undeveloped land, a significant presence of unimproved roads, or 13 significant agricultural activity; and

(3) ensure that any housing tax credits allocated to a
designated rural area <u>described by Subsection (a)(1) or (2)</u> comply
with applicable federal requirements regarding that assistance.

17 (c) The department shall remove a rural area designation 18 under this section on receipt of a request submitted on behalf of 19 the affected political subdivision, census-designated place, or 20 development site, as applicable.

21 SECTION 2. Section 2306.111(d-4), Government Code, is 22 repealed.

23 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date 24 of this Act, the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs 25 shall adopt rules to implement the changes in law made by this Act.

26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
