(a) The executive commissioner, after consultation with the 10 department, by rule shall develop standards for the adequate 11 12 provision of quality mental health services to individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and co-occurring 13 14 mental health conditions, including substance use conditions, who are residing in department facilities. 15 16 (b) In developing the standards under Subsection (a), the executive commissioner shall emphasize the importance of 17 trauma-informed care and ensure that the mental health services 18 provided to individuals described by Subsection (a) include 19 services relating to: 20 21 (1) assessment; 22 (2) evaluation, including evaluation for past trauma; 23 (3) diagnosis; 24 (4) treatment; and

2	(c) The executive commissioner, with stakeholder input and
3	after holding a public hearing, shall review and update the
4	standards every five years.
5	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 534, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 534.0525 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 534.0525. STANDARDS FOR COMMUNITY-BASED MENTAL HEALTH
8	SERVICES PROVIDED TO INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLECTUAL AND
9	DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES. (a) The executive commissioner, after
10	consultation with the department, by rule shall develop standards
11	for the adequate provision of quality community-based mental health
12	services through a local mental health authority under this
13	subchapter to individuals with intellectual and developmental
14	disabilities and co-occurring mental health conditions, including
15	substance use conditions.
16	(b) In developing the standards under Subsection (a), the
17	executive commissioner shall emphasize the importance of
18	trauma-informed care and ensure that the mental health services
19	provided to the individuals described by Subsection (a) include the
20	services required by Section 534.053 and services relating to:
21	(1) assessment;
22	(2) evaluation, including evaluation for past trauma;
23	(3) diagnosis;
24	(4) treatment; and
25	(5) recovery.
26	(c) The executive commissioner, with stakeholder input and
27	after holding a public hearing, shall review and update the

## 1 standards every five years.

2 SECTION 3. The executive commissioner of the Health and 3 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules as required by Sections 4 533.054 and 534.0525, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, 5 as soon as practicable.

6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
