- 6 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2018, the Texas Higher
- 7 Education Coordinating Board shall submit its initial report
- 8 required under Section 56.082, Education Code, as amended by this
- 9 Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
