- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sec. 140.001., Local Government Code is amended
- 5 by adding subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 140.001. RELIEF UNDER FEDERAL BANKRUPTCY LAWS FOR
- 7 MUNICIPALITY, TAXING DISTRICT, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. (a)
- 8 A municipality, taxing district, or other political subdivision
- 9 that is subject to this section may proceed under all federal
- 10 bankruptcy laws intended to relieve municipal indebtedness.
- 11 (b) A municipality is subject to this section if it has the
- 12 power to incur indebtedness through the action of its governing
- 13 body. A taxing district or other political subdivision is subject
- 14 to this section if it has the power to incur indebtedness either
- 15 through the action of its governing body or through that of the
- 16 county or municipality in which it is located.
- 17 (c) The officials and governing body of the municipality,
- 18 taxing district, or other political subdivision may adopt all
- 19 proceedings and take any action necessary or convenient to fully
- 20 avail the entity of the federal bankruptcy laws.
- 21 (d) A home rule municipality that adopts proceedings to
- 22 avail the municipality of federal bankruptcy laws or otherwise
- 23 seeks bankruptcy protection forfeits its home rule charter.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
