4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1702.1305 to read as follows:

- Sec. 1702.1305. REQUIREMENTS FOR USE OF INSIGNIAS AND

  BESIGNS BY GUARD COMPANIES. (a) This section applies only to a

  person who holds a security services contractor license and acts
- 10 as, offers to provide the services of, or engages in the business of
- 11 a guard company.
- 12 (b) A person may not use an insignia or design on a uniform
- 13 or motor vehicle that will be used by the person or the person's
- 14 officer, director, partner, manager, or employee while performing
- 15 duties as a guard company under this chapter unless the person:
- 16 (1) submits the insignia or design to the department;
- 17 and
- 18 (2) obtains the department's approval to use the
- 19 insignia or design on the uniform or motor vehicle.
- (c) The board by rule shall prescribe procedures for the
- 21 <u>submission</u> and approval of an insignia or design under this
- 22 section.
- 23 <u>(d) The rules may require that a person subject to this</u>
- 24 section submit a proposed insignia or design for department

- 1 approval as a part of the person's application for a license if the
- 2 person intends to use an insignia or design in the manner described
- 3 by Subsection (b).
- 4 (e) The board may not renew the license of a person who
- 5 violates this section or a rule adopted under this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. Not later than March 31, 2018, the Texas Private
- 7 Security Board shall adopt rules to implement Section 1702.1305,
- 8 Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 1702.1305(e), Occupations Code, as added
- 10 by this Act, applies only to the renewal of a security services
- 11 contractor license that expires on or after September 1, 2018. A
- 12 security services contractor license that expires before that date
- 13 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 14 date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 15 purpose.
- SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 17 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
- 18 (b) Section 1702.1305, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 19 Act, takes effect September 1, 2018.
