- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.051(d), Labor Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) The employee may file the wage claim:
- 8 (1) in person at an office of the commission;
- 9 (2) by mailing the claim to an address designated by
- 10 the commission;
- 11 (3) by faxing the claim to a fax number designated by
- 12 the commission; $[\frac{or}{}]$
- 13 (4) electronically in a manner designated by the
- 14 commission by rule; or
- 15 (5) by any other means adopted by the commission by
- 16 rule.
- 17 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2017, the Texas
- 18 Workforce Commission shall adopt rules for the administration of
- 19 Section 61.051(d), Labor Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to a wage claim that is filed with the Texas Workforce Commission on
- 22 or after January 1, 2018. A wage claim filed before that date is
- 23 governed by the law in effect on the date that the claim was filed,
- 24 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
