9	(2) by mailing the claim to an address designated by

11	(3) by faxing the claim to a fax number designated by
12	the commission; [or]
13	(4) <u>electronically in a manner designated by the</u>
14	commission by rule; or
15	(5) by any other means adopted by the commission by
16	rule.
17	SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2017, the Texas
18	Workforce Commission shall adopt rules for the administration of
19	Section 61.051(d), Labor Code, as amended by this Act.
20	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to a wage claim that is filed with the Texas Workforce Commission on
22	or after January 1, 2018. A wage claim filed before that date is
23	governed by the law in effect on the date that the claim was filed,
24	and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
