- 14 (3) the commissioner or a representative designated by 15 the commissioner;
- (4) the commissioner of the Texas Education Agency 16 [aging and disability services] or a representative designated by 17 the commissioner [of aging and disability services]; and 18
- 19 (5) the following members appointed by the governor:
- (A) three health care professionals from the 20
- 21 allied health, dental, medical, mental health, and pharmacy
- professions, no two of whom may be from the same profession; 22
- 23 (B) one registered nurse;
- 24 (C) two representatives of a university

- 1 health-related institution of higher education;
- 2 (D) one representative of a junior or community
- 3 college with a nursing program;
- 4 (E) one hospital administrator;
- 5 (F) one managed care administrator; and
- 6 (G) four public members.
- SECTION 2. On the effective date of this Act, the commissioner of the Texas Education Agency or a representative designated by the commissioner of the Texas Education Agency
- 10 replaces the commissioner of aging and disability services or the
- 11 representative designated by the commissioner of aging and
- 12 disability services as a member of the statewide health
- 13 coordinating council, in accordance with Section 104.011, Health
- 14 and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, and the commissioner of the
- 15 Texas Education Agency shall serve the remainder of the unexpired
- 16 term.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
