## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to public access to certain information and materials 2 relating to certain hospital inspections and investigations. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 241.051(d), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 Information [All information and materials] obtained or (d) compiled by the department in connection with a complaint or [and] 8 investigation that is [concerning a hospital are] confidential by 9 law, such as individually identifiable information concerning a 10 patient or health care professional, is [and] not subject to 11 disclosure under Chapter 552 [Section 552.001 et seq.], Government 12 Code[, and not subject to disclosure, discovery, subpoena, or other 13 14 means of legal compulsion for their release to anyone other than the department or its employees or agents involved in the enforcement 15 action except that this information may be disclosed to: 16 17 [(1) persons involved with the department in the 18 enforcement action against the hospital; 19 [(2) the hospital that is the subject of the enforcement action, or the hospital's authorized representative; 20 21 [(3) appropriate state or federal agencies that are 22 authorized to inspect, survey, or investigate hospital services; 23 [(4) law enforcement agencies; and 24 [(5) persons engaged in bona fide research, if all

3	SECTION 2. Section 577.013(d), Health and Safety Code, is
4	amended to read as follows:
5	(d) <u>Information</u> [ <del>All information and materials</del> ] obtained or
6	compiled by the department in connection with a complaint <u>or</u> [ <del>and</del> ]
7	investigation <u>that is</u> [ <del>concerning a mental hospital licensed under</del>
8	this chapter are] confidential by law, such as individually
9	identifiable information concerning a patient or health care
10	professional, is [and] not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552,
11	Government Code [, discovery, subpoena, or other means of legal
12	compulsion for their release to anyone other than the department or
13	its employees or agents involved in the enforcement action except
14	that this information may be disclosed to:
15	[ <del>(1) persons involved with the department in the</del>
16	enforcement action against the licensed mental hospital;
17	[ <del>(2) the licensed mental hospital that is the subject</del>
18	of the enforcement action, or the licensed mental hospital's
19	authorized representative;
20	[ <del>(3) appropriate state or federal agencies that are</del>
21	authorized to inspect, survey, or investigate licensed mental
22	hospital services;
23	[(4) law enforcement agencies; and
24	[ <del>(5) persons engaged in bona fide research, if all</del>
25	individual-identifying information and information identifying the
26	licensed mental hospital has been deleted].
27	SECTION 3. Sections 241.051(e) and 577.013(e), Health and

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1 Safety Code, are repealed.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
