- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 571.140, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), [or] (b-1), or 10 (b-2) or by Section 571.171, proceedings at a preliminary review hearing performed by the commission, a sworn complaint or motion, 11 12 and documents and any additional evidence relating to the processing, preliminary review, preliminary review hearing, or 13 resolution of a sworn complaint or motion are confidential and may 14 not be disclosed unless entered into the record of a formal hearing 15 16 or a judicial proceeding, except that a document or statement that 17 was previously public information remains public information.
- 18 <u>(b-2) A respondent named in a sworn complaint or motion</u>
 19 <u>waives confidentiality regarding any proceedings and information</u>
 20 <u>relating to the sworn complaint or motion, with respect to the</u>
 21 <u>respondent, by:</u>
- 22 (1) publicly disclosing confidential information 23 relating to the sworn complaint or motion; or
- 24 (2) providing a verified, written waiver of

- 1 confidentiality to the executive director.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
