- 2 relating to the establishment of a veterans self-help center.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 434.0195 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 434.0195. VETERANS SELF-HELP CENTER. (a) The Texas
- 7 Veterans Commission shall establish a veterans self-help center in
- 8 a municipality with a population of more than 1.3 million located in
- 9 a county in which three or more locations of a joint military base
- 10 are located.
- 11 (b) In determining a location for the self-help center, the
- 12 commission shall ensure that the center is located in an area of the
- 13 <u>municipality without United States Department of Veterans Affairs</u>
- 14 offices and treatment centers.
- 15 (c) The self-help center must provide access to appropriate
- 16 veterans services and resources, including through staff and
- 17 information technology services. The commission shall coordinate
- 18 with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs and any other
- 19 appropriate state or federal agency, as necessary, to carry out the
- 20 functions of the self-help center.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
