A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to disclosure requirements of certain nursing facilities
- 3 that provide care for persons with Alzheimer's disease and related
- 4 disorders.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 242.0405 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 242.0405. NOTICE OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED
- 9 DISORDERS CERTIFICATION. (a) A nursing facility shall prepare a
- 10 written notice disclosing whether the facility is certified or is
- 11 not certified under Section 242.040 for the provision of
- 12 specialized care and treatment of residents with Alzheimer's
- 13 <u>disease and related disorders.</u>
- 14 (b) The nursing facility shall provide the notice described
- 15 by Subsection (a) to:
- 16 (1) each resident of the facility;
- 17 (2) each person applying for services from the
- 18 facility or the person's next of kin or guardian; and
- 19 (3) any person requesting the information.
- 20 <u>(c) A nursing facility shall keep a record of each person to</u>
- 21 whom notice is provided under Subsection (b).
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 242.042, Health and Safety Code, is
- 23 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 24 (a-1) In addition to the information displayed under

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- 1 Subsection (a), each institution shall prominently and
- 2 conspicuously post for display in a public area of the institution
- 3 that is readily available to residents, employees, and visitors a
- 4 written notice described by Section 242.0405.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 242.202(d), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The disclosure statement must contain the following
- 8 categories of information:
- 9 (1) the institution's philosophy of care;
- 10 (2) [whether the institution is certified under
- 11 Section 242.040 for the provision of specialized care and treatment
- 12 of residents with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders;
- 13 $\left[\frac{(3)}{}\right]$ the preadmission, admission, and discharge
- 14 process;
- 15 $\underline{(3)}$ [$\underline{(4)}$] resident assessment, care planning, and
- 16 implementation of the care plan;
- 17 (4) $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ staffing patterns, such as
- 18 resident-to-staff ratios, and staff training;
- 19 (5) $\left[\frac{(6)}{(6)}\right]$ the physical environment of the
- 20 institution;
- 21 (6) (7) resident activities;
- 22 (7) [(8)] program costs;
- 23 (8) [(9)] systems for evaluation of the institution's
- 24 programs for residents;
- (9) $[\frac{(10)}{(10)}]$ family involvement in resident care; and
- (10) $[\frac{(11)}{}]$ the toll-free telephone number maintained
- 27 by the department for acceptance of complaints against the

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- 1 institution.
- 2 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- $\ensuremath{\mathtt{3}}$ of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 4 Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement the changes in
- 5 law made by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
