A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the investigation of fraud, waste, and abuse in certain 3 public benefits programs by the office of inspector general for the 4 Health and Human Services Commission.

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 31, Human Resources Code, 7 is amended by adding Section 31.045 to read as follows:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 <u>Sec. 31.045. PEACE OFFICERS. The commission's office of</u> 9 <u>inspector general may employ and commission peace officers for the</u> 10 <u>purpose of assisting the office in the investigation of fraud,</u> 11 <u>waste, or abuse in the financial assistance program. A peace</u> 12 <u>officer employed and commissioned by the office is a peace officer</u> 13 <u>for purposes of Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure.</u>

SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code,
is amended by adding Section 33.032 to read as follows:

16 <u>Sec. 33.032. PEACE OFFICERS. The commission's office of</u> 17 <u>inspector general may employ and commission peace officers for the</u> 18 <u>purpose of assisting the office in the investigation of fraud,</u> 19 <u>waste, or abuse in the supplemental nutrition assistance program.</u> 20 <u>A peace officer employed and commissioned by the office is a peace</u> 21 officer for purposes of Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure.

22 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act 23 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 24 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

1 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 3 waiver or authorization is granted.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
