Section 408.025, Labor Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: 6 7 (a-1) A treating doctor may delegate to a physician assistant who is licensed to practice in this state under Chapter 8 204, Occupations Code, the authority to complete and sign a work 9 status report regarding an injured employee's ability to return to 10 11 work. The delegating treating doctor is responsible for the acts of 12 the physician assistant under this subsection. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 17
