A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a sales and use tax exemption for property used in the
- 3 production of motion picture, video or audio master recordings.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 151.3185, Tax Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (e) and adding Subsection (h) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) The sale, lease, or rental or storage, use, or other
- 9 consumption of the following items are exempted from the taxes
- 10 imposed by this chapter:
- 11 (1) tangible personal property that will become an
- 12 ingredient or component part of:
- (A) a motion picture, [or] video, or audio master
- 14 recording, a copy of which is sold or offered for ultimate sale,
- 15 licensed, distributed, broadcast, or otherwise exhibited <u>for</u>
- 16 consideration; or
- 17 (B) a broadcast by a producer of cable programs
- 18 or by a radio or television station licensed by the Federal
- 19 Communications Commission;
- 20 (2) tangible personal property that is necessary or
- 21 essential to and used or consumed in or during:
- (A) the production of a motion picture, [or]
- 23 video, or audio master recording, a copy of which is sold or offered
- 24 for ultimate sale, licensed, distributed, broadcast, or otherwise

- 1 exhibited <u>for consideration</u>; or
- 2 (B) the production of a broadcast by or for a
- 3 cable program producer or by or for a radio or television station
- 4 licensed by the Federal Communications Commission; and
- 5 (3) except as provided by Subsection (c), services
- 6 that are necessary and essential to and used directly in a
- 7 production described by Subdivision (2)(A) or (B).
- 8 (e) The sale of a motion picture, video, or audio master
- 9 recording by the producer of the master is exempt from the taxes
- 10 imposed by this chapter.
- 11 (h) For purposes of this section, "master recording" means
- 12 the principal media on which images, sound, or a combination of
- 13 images and sound are first fixed, and from which copies are
- 14 commercially made available for sale, license, distribution,
- 15 broadcast, or exhibition of the master recording or copies for
- 16 <u>consideration</u>.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to
- 18 master recordings sold, leased, rented, stored, used, or otherwise
- 19 consumed on or after the effective date of this Act. Master
- 20 recordings sold, leased, rented, stored, used, or otherwise
- 21 consumed before that date are governed by the law in effect on the
- 22 date of the sale, lease, rental, storage, use, or other consumption
- 23 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
