7	SECTION 1. Section 490G.001, Government Code, is amended by
8	amending Subdivisions (1) and (2-a) and adding Subdivisions (1-a),
9	(2-b), and (4) to read as follows:
10	(1) "Authorizing municipality" means the municipality
11	that authorizes the creation of a Type A or Type B corporation.
12	<u>(1-a)</u> "Board" means the Economic Incentive Oversight
13	Board.
14	(2-a) <u>"Office" means the Texas Economic Development</u>
15	and Tourism Office.
16	(2-b) "Rural county" means a county with a population
17	of less than 60,000.
18	(4) "Type A corporation" and "Type B corporation" have
19	the meanings assigned those terms by Section 501.002, Local
20	Government Code.
21	SECTION 2. Chapter 490G, Government Code, is amended by
22	adding Sections 490G.0055 and 490G.0056 to read as follows:

24	PROJECTS; PERFORMANCE MATRIX. (a) The board shall examine the

Sec. 490G.0056. REVIEW OF PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY TEXAS 13 14 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACT; PERFORMANCE MATRIX. (a) The board shall 15 examine the effectiveness, efficiency, and financial impact on this state of the ad valorem tax incentive program established by 16 17 Chapter 313, Tax Code, including whether that chapter is being implemented by school districts and the comptroller in such a way as 18 19 to: (1) accomplish the purposes of that chapter as 20 expressed in Section 313.003 of that chapter; and 21 (2) comply with the intent of the legislature in 22 enacting that chapter as expressed in Section 313.004 of that 23 24 chapter. (b) The board shall develop a performance matrix that 25 26 clearly establishes the economic performance indicators, measures, and metrics that will guide the board's evaluation of the program. 27

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(c) The comptroller shall provide to the board on request
information concerning the program as necessary to enable the board
to perform the board's duties under this chapter.

4 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 490G.006, Government 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:

6 Sec. 490G.006. SCHEDULE OF REVIEW <u>OF STATE INCENTIVE</u> 7 PROGRAMS; RECOMMENDATION TO LEGISLATIVE AUDIT COMMITTEE.

8 SECTION 4. Chapter 490G, Government Code, is amended by 9 adding Sections 490G.0065 and 490G.0066 to read as follows:

Sec. 490G.0065. SCHEDULE OF REVIEW OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 10 CORPORATION PROJECTS. (a) The board shall develop a schedule for 11 12 the periodic review of each project or category of projects described by Section 490G.0055 and identified by the board for the 13 purposes of making recommendations concerning project 14 15 effectiveness and efficiency to the office and reporting the findings and recommendations resulting from the project review to 16 17 the legislature as required by Section 490G.007. The board shall review and make findings and recommendations regarding each project 18 19 or category of projects as described by this section according to the review schedule. 20

(b) The board, on request, shall provide to the governing body of a Type A corporation's or Type B corporation's authorizing municipality any recommendations submitted to the office under Subsection (a) concerning a project or category of projects undertaken by the corporation created by the municipality.

26Sec. 490G.0066.SCHEDULE OF REVIEW OF PROGRAM ESTABLISHED27BY TEXAS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACT. (a) The board shall develop a

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1 schedule for the periodic review of the ad valorem tax incentive program established by Chapter 313, Tax Code, for the purpose of 2 3 making recommendations concerning the effectiveness and efficiency of the program to the office and reporting the findings and 4 recommendations resulting from the review to the legislature as 5 required by Section 490G.007. The board shall review and make 6 7 findings and recommendations regarding the program according to the 8 review schedule. The board, on request, shall provide to the governing 9 (b) 10 body of a school district or the comptroller any recommendations submitted to the office under Subsection (a) concerning the 11 12 program. SECTION 5. Section 490G.007, Government Code, is amended to 13 14 read as follows: Sec. 490G.007. BIENNIAL REPORT. Not later than January 1 15 of each odd-numbered year, the board shall submit to the lieutenant 16 17 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each standing committee of the senate and house of representatives with 18 19 primary jurisdiction over economic development a report containing findings and recommendations resulting from each review of state 20 incentive programs and funds, of projects undertaken by Type A or 21 Type B corporations, and of the ad valorem tax incentive program 22 established by Chapter 313, Tax Code, that is conducted by the board 23 24 under this chapter during the preceding two calendar years. SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 25

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
