A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to establishment of a research and clinical care center for combat-related posttraumatic stress disorder and related 3 conditions. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 74, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 74.155 to read as follows: Sec. 74.155. NATIONAL CENTER FOR WARRIOR RESILIENCY.(a) 8 In this section, "PTSD" means posttraumatic stress disorder and 9 10 related conditions. 11 (b) The University of Texas Health Science Center at San 12 Antonio shall establish and maintain the National Center for Warrior Resiliency, a center devoted to research and clinical care 13 14 regarding: (1) the detection, prevention, diagnosis, and 15 16 treatment of combat-related PTSD and comorbid conditions; and (2) enhancing the psychological resiliency of 17 military personnel and veterans. 18 (c) The center shall foster multi-disciplinary and multi-19 institutional research collaborations, and for that purpose may 20 21 establish or participate in research consortia with other Texas and national public and private institutions of higher education 22 23 and appropriate federal agencies such as the United States Veterans Administration, the United States Department of Defense, 24

1 and the National Institutes of Health.

2 <u>(d) The health science center shall seek funding for center</u> 3 <u>operations through gifts, grants, donations, including sponsored</u> 4 <u>research.</u>

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 the vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
