A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain requirements imposed on a sex offender who
- 3 enters the premises of a school.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 62.053(a), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Before a person who will be subject to registration
- 8 under this chapter is due to be released from a penal institution,
- 9 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or the Texas Juvenile
- 10 Justice Department shall determine the person's level of risk to
- 11 the community using the sex offender screening tool developed or
- 12 selected under Article 62.007 and assign to the person a numeric
- 13 risk level of one, two, or three. Before releasing the person, an
- 14 official of the penal institution shall:
- 15 (1) inform the person that:
- 16 (A) not later than the later of the seventh day
- 17 after the date on which the person is released or after the date on
- 18 which the person moves from a previous residence to a new residence
- 19 in this state or not later than the first date the applicable local
- 20 law enforcement authority by policy allows the person to register
- 21 or verify registration, the person must register or verify
- 22 registration with the local law enforcement authority in the
- 23 municipality or county in which the person intends to reside;
- 24 (B) not later than the seventh day after the date

- 1 on which the person is released or the date on which the person
- 2 moves from a previous residence to a new residence in this state,
- 3 the person must, if the person has not moved to an intended
- 4 residence, report to the applicable entity or entities as required
- 5 by Article 62.051(h) or (j) or 62.055(e);
- 6 (C) not later than the seventh day before the
- 7 date on which the person moves to a new residence in this state or
- 8 another state, the person must report in person to the local law
- 9 enforcement authority designated as the person's primary
- 10 registration authority by the department and to the juvenile
- 11 probation officer, community supervision and corrections
- 12 department officer, or parole officer supervising the person;
- 13 (D) not later than the 10th day after the date on
- 14 which the person arrives in another state in which the person
- 15 intends to reside, the person must register with the law
- 16 enforcement agency that is identified by the department as the
- 17 agency designated by that state to receive registration
- 18 information, if the other state has a registration requirement for
- 19 sex offenders;
- 20 (E) not later than the 30th day after the date on
- 21 which the person is released, the person must apply to the
- 22 department in person for the issuance of an original or renewal
- 23 driver's license or personal identification certificate and a
- 24 failure to apply to the department as required by this paragraph
- 25 results in the automatic revocation of any driver's license or
- 26 personal identification certificate issued by the department to the
- 27 person;

- 1 (F) the person must notify appropriate entities
- 2 of any change in status as described by Article 62.057; [and]
- 3 (G) certain types of employment are prohibited
- 4 under Article 62.063 for a person with a reportable conviction or
- 5 adjudication for a sexually violent offense involving a victim
- 6 younger than 14 years of age occurring on or after September 1,
- 7 2013; and
- 8 <u>(H) if the person enters or goes within 25 feet of</u>
- 9 the premises of a school as described by Article 62.064 and is
- 10 subject to the requirements of that article, the person must
- 11 immediately notify the administrative office of the school of the
- 12 person's presence and the person's registration status under this
- 13 chapter;
- 14 (2) require the person to sign a written statement
- 15 that the person was informed of the person's duties as described by
- 16 Subdivision (1) or Subsection (g) or, if the person refuses to sign
- 17 the statement, certify that the person was so informed;
- 18 (3) obtain the address or, if applicable, a detailed
- 19 description of each geographical location where the person expects
- 20 to reside on the person's release and other registration
- 21 information, including a photograph and complete set of
- 22 fingerprints; and
- 23 (4) complete the registration form for the person.
- 24 SECTION 2. Article 62.058, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 25 amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 26 (g) A local law enforcement authority who provides a person
- 27 with a registration form for verification as required by this

- 1 chapter shall include with the form a statement and, if applicable,
- 2 a description of the person's duty to provide notice under Article
- 3 62.064.
- 4 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 62, Code of Criminal
- 5 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 62.064 to read as follows:
- Art. 62.064. ENTRY ONTO OR PRESENCE NEAR SCHOOL PREMISES;
- 7 NOTICE REQUIRED. (a) In this article:
- 8 (1) "Premises" means a building or portion of a
- 9 building and the grounds on which the building is located,
- 10 including any public or private driveway, street, sidewalk or
- 11 walkway, parking lot, or parking garage on the grounds.
- 12 (2) "School" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 13 481.134, Health and Safety Code.
- 14 (b) A person subject to registration under this chapter who
- 15 enters the premises of any school in this state or goes within 25
- 16 <u>feet of the premises of a school in this state during the standard</u>
- 17 operating hours of the school shall immediately notify the
- 18 administrative office of the school of the person's presence on the
- 19 premises of the school and the person's registration status under
- 20 this chapter. The office may provide a chaperon to accompany the
- 21 person while the person is on the premises of the school.
- 22 (c) The requirements of this article:
- 23 (1) are in addition to any requirement associated with
- 24 the imposition of a child safety zone on the person under Section
- 25 508.187, Government Code, or Article 42A.453; and
- 26 (2) do not apply to:
- 27 (A) a student enrolled at the school; or

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- 1 (B) a student from another school participating
- 2 at an event at the school.
- 3 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 4 person subject to registration under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal
- 5 Procedure, for an offense committed or conduct that occurs before,
- 6 on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
