A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to certain requirements imposed on a sex offender who 3 enters the premises of a school.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Article 62.053(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, 6 is amended to read as follows:

7 (a) Before a person who will be subject to registration under this chapter is due to be released from a penal institution, 8 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or the Texas Juvenile 9 Justice Department shall determine the person's level of risk to 10 11 the community using the sex offender screening tool developed or selected under Article 62.007 and assign to the person a numeric 12 risk level of one, two, or three. Before releasing the person, an 13 14 official of the penal institution shall:

(1) inform the person that:

(A) not later than the later of the seventh day 16 after the date on which the person is released or after the date on 17 which the person moves from a previous residence to a new residence 18 in this state or not later than the first date the applicable local 19 law enforcement authority by policy allows the person to register 20 21 or verify registration, the person must register or verify registration with the local law enforcement authority in the 22 23 municipality or county in which the person intends to reside; 24 (B) not later than the seventh day after the date

1 on which the person is released or the date on which the person 2 moves from a previous residence to a new residence in this state, 3 the person must, if the person has not moved to an intended 4 residence, report to the applicable entity or entities as required 5 by Article 62.051(h) or (j) or 62.055(e);

(C) not later than the seventh day before the 6 7 date on which the person moves to a new residence in this state or another state, the person must report in person to the local law 8 as the person's enforcement authority designated 9 primary 10 registration authority by the department and to the juvenile probation officer, community supervision and corrections 11 department officer, or parole officer supervising the person; 12

not later than the 10th day after the date on 13 (D) 14 which the person arrives in another state in which the person 15 intends to reside, the person must register with the law enforcement agency that is identified by the department as the 16 17 designated by that state to receive registration agency information, if the other state has a registration requirement for 18 sex offenders; 19

(E) not later than the 30th day after the date on 20 which the person is released, the person must apply to the 21 department in person for the issuance of an original or renewal 22 driver's license or personal identification certificate and a 23 24 failure to apply to the department as required by this paragraph results in the automatic revocation of any driver's license or 25 26 personal identification certificate issued by the department to the 27 person;

No. 2575 1 (F) the person must notify appropriate entities 2 of any change in status as described by Article 62.057; [and] 3 (G) certain types of employment are prohibited under Article 62.063 for a person with a reportable conviction or 4 5 adjudication for a sexually violent offense involving a victim younger than 14 years of age occurring on or after September 1, 6 2013; and 7 8 (H) if the person enters the premises of a school 9 as described by Article 62.064 and is subject to the requirements of 10 that article, the person must immediately notify the administrative office of the school of the person's presence on the premises of the 11 12 school and the person's registration status under this chapter; require the person to sign a written statement 13 (2) 14 that the person was informed of the person's duties as described by 15 Subdivision (1) or Subsection (g) or, if the person refuses to sign the statement, certify that the person was so informed; 16 17 (3) obtain the address or, if applicable, a detailed description of each geographical location where the person expects 18 19 to reside on the person's release and other registration information, including a photograph 20 and complete of set fingerprints; and 21 (4) complete the registration form for the person. 22 SECTION 2. Article 62.058, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 23 24 amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows: (g) A local law enforcement authority who provides a person 25 26 with a registration form for verification as required by this chapter shall include with the form a statement and, if applicable, 27

3 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 62, Code of Criminal 4 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 62.064 to read as follows:

5 Art. 62.064. ENTRY ONTO SCHOOL PREMISES; NOTICE REQUIRED.

6 (a) In this article, "school" has the meaning assigned by Section
7 481.134, Health and Safety Code.

8 (b) A person subject to registration under this chapter who 9 enters the premises of any school in this state during the standard 10 operating hours of the school shall immediately notify the 11 administrative office of the school of the person's presence on the 12 premises of the school and the person's registration status under 13 this chapter. The office may provide a chaperon to accompany the 14 person while the person is on the premises of the school.

(c) The requirements of this article:

16 (1) are in addition to any requirement associated with 17 the imposition of a child safety zone on the person under Section 18 508.187, Government Code, or Article 42A.453; and

19 (2) do not apply to:

(A) a student enrolled at the school; or

21 (B) a student from another school participating 22 at an event at the school.

23 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 24 person subject to registration under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal 25 Procedure, for an offense committed or conduct that occurs before, 26 on, or after the effective date of this Act.

27 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
