A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN	ACT
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- 2 relating to the regulation of bingo games; authorizing fee refunds.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2001.057(a), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The commission shall [may] appoint a bingo advisory
- 7 committee consisting of nine members. The commission shall appoint
- 8 members representing a balance of interests including
- 9 representatives of:
- 10 (1) the public;
- 11 (2) charities that operate bingo games; and
- 12 (3) commercial and charity lessors that participate in
- 13 the bingo industry.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 2001.103, Occupations Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 16 <u>(a-1)</u> On request, the commission shall refund to an
- 17 <u>authorized organization the \$25 temporary license fee submitted</u>
- 18 under Subsection (a) not later than the 30th day after the date the
- 19 commission receives the request for the refund, if:
- 20 <u>(1) the authorized organization does not use the</u>
- 21 temporary license to conduct bingo before the first anniversary of
- 22 the date of the license's issuance; or
- 23 (2) the authorized organization requests withdrawal
- 24 of the application before the temporary license is issued, except

- 1 the commission may retain an amount not to exceed 50 percent of the
- 2 license fee to defray any administrative cost incurred by the
- 3 commission in processing the application.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 2001.104, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 6 (f) The commission shall refund the fee for an initial or
- 7 renewal license to conduct bingo if the applicant requests
- 8 withdrawal of the application before the license is issued or if the
- 9 commission denies the application, except the commission may retain
- 10 <u>an amount not to exceed the lesser of 50 percent of the license fee</u>
- 11 or \$150 to defray any administrative cost incurred by the
- 12 commission in processing the application. The commission shall
- 13 issue the refund not later than the 30th day after the date the
- 14 commission receives the withdrawal request or denies the
- 15 application.
- SECTION 4. Section 2001.158, Occupations Code, is amended
- 17 by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 18 (e) The commission shall refund the fee for an initial or
- 19 renewal commercial lessor license if the applicant requests
- 20 withdrawal of the application before the license is issued or if the
- 21 <u>commission denies the application, except the commission may retain</u>
- 22 an amount not to exceed the lesser of 50 percent of the license fee
- 23 or \$150 to defray any administrative cost incurred by the
- 24 commission in processing the application. The commission shall
- 25 <u>issue the refund not later than the 30th day after the date the</u>
- 26 commission receives the withdrawal request or denies the
- 27 application.

- 1 SECTION 5. Section 2001.205, Occupations Code, is amended
- 2 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 (c) The commission shall refund the fee for an initial or
- 4 renewal manufacturer's license if the applicant requests
- 5 withdrawal of the application before the license is issued or if the
- 6 commission denies the application, except the commission may retain
- 7 a reasonable amount set by the commission to defray any
- 8 administrative cost incurred by the commission in processing the
- 9 application. The commission shall issue the refund not later than
- 10 the 30th day after the date the commission receives the withdrawal
- 11 request or denies the application.
- 12 SECTION 6. Section 2001.209, Occupations Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 14 (c) The commission shall refund the fee for an initial or
- 15 renewal distributor's license if the applicant requests withdrawal
- 16 of the application before the license is issued or if the commission
- 17 denies the application, except the commission may retain a
- 18 reasonable amount set by the commission to defray any
- 19 administrative cost incurred by the commission in processing the
- 20 application. The commission shall issue the refund not later than
- 21 the 30th day after the date the commission receives the withdrawal
- 22 request or denies the application.
- 23 SECTION 7. Section 2001.306, Occupations Code, is amended
- 24 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 25 <u>(f) The commission shall refund the fee for amending a</u>
- 26 license issued under this chapter if the applicant requests
- 27 withdrawal of the amendment application before the amended license

- 1 is issued or if the commission denies the amendment application,
- 2 except the commission may retain an amount not to exceed 50 percent
- 3 of the amendment fee to defray any administrative cost incurred by
- 4 the commission in processing the amendment application. The
- 5 commission shall issue the refund not later than the 30th day after
- 6 the date the commission receives the withdrawal request or denies
- 7 the application.
- 8 SECTION 8. Section 2001.313, Occupations Code, is amended
- 9 by adding Subsection (b-3) and amending Subsection (h) to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 (b-3) The commission shall refund the fee submitted under
- 12 Subsection (b-2) for an initial or renewal registration application
- 13 <u>if the applicant requests withdrawal of the application before the</u>
- 14 applicant is listed on the registry or if the commission denies the
- 15 registration and listing, except the commission may retain an
- 16 amount not to exceed 50 percent of the registration fee to defray
- 17 any administrative cost incurred by the commission in processing
- 18 the application. The commission shall issue the refund not later
- 19 than the 30th day after the date the commission receives the
- 20 withdrawal request or denies the application.
- 21 (h) A licensed authorized organization may employ an
- 22 individual who is not on the registry established by this section as
- 23 an operator, manager, cashier, usher, caller, or salesperson on a
- 24 provisional basis if the individual is awaiting the results of a
- 25 background check by the commission:
- 26 (1) for a period not to exceed 14 days, beginning on
- 27 the date the commission receives the application for the employee

- 1 to be placed on the registry, if the individual is a resident of
- 2 this state; or
- 3 (2) for a period to be established by commission rule
- 4 if the individual is not a resident of this state.
- 5 SECTION 9. Section 2001.419, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) If pull-tab bingo tickets are sold by one licensed
- 8 authorized organization that conducts consecutive bingo occasions
- 9 during one day, the organization may account for and report all of
- 10 the pull-tab bingo ticket sales for the occasions as sales for the
- 11 final occasion.
- 12 SECTION 10. Section 2001.437, Occupations Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 14 (i) The commission shall refund the fee for an initial or
- 15 renewal unit manager license if the applicant requests withdrawal
- 16 of the application before the license is issued or if the commission
- 17 denies the application, except the commission may retain an amount
- 18 not to exceed the lesser of 50 percent of the license fee or \$150 to
- 19 defray any administrative cost incurred by the commission in
- 20 processing the application. The commission shall issue the refund
- 21 not later than the 30th day after the date the commission receives
- 22 the withdrawal request or denies the application.
- 23 SECTION 11. Section 2001.502, Occupations Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:
- Sec. 2001.502. PRIZE FEE. A licensed authorized
- 26 organization shall:
- 27 (1) collect from a person who wins a bingo prize of

- 1 more than \$5 a fee in the amount of five percent of the amount or
- 2 value of the prize; and
- 3 (2) remit to the commission a fee in the amount of five
- 4 percent of the amount or value of all bingo prizes of more than \$5
- 5 awarded.
- 6 SECTION 12. Section 2001.0541, Occupations Code, is 7 repealed.
- 8 SECTION 13. (a) Chapter 2001, Occupations Code, as amended
- 9 by this Act, applies only to an application and fee submitted under
- 10 that chapter on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 11 application and fee submitted before the effective date of this Act
- 12 are governed by the law in effect on the date the application and
- 13 fee are submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 14 that purpose.
- 15 (b) Notwithstanding the effective date of this Act, the
- 16 change in law made to Section 2001.502, Occupations Code, applies
- 17 to the collection or remittance of a bingo prize fee for a bingo
- 18 prize awarded on or after October 1, 2017. The collection or
- 19 remittance of a bingo prize fee for a bingo prize awarded before
- 20 October 1, 2017, is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 21 prize is awarded, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 22 purpose.
- 23 SECTION 14. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
