A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to an exemption for certain quarries from regulation as

- 3 aggregate production operations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28A.001(1), Water Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) "Aggregate production operation" means the site
- 8 from which aggregates are being or have been removed or extracted
- 9 from the earth, including the entire areas of extraction, stripped
- 10 areas, haulage ramps, and the land on which the plant processing the
- 11 raw materials is located, exclusive of any land owned or leased by
- 12 the responsible party not being currently used in the production of
- 13 aggregates. For the purposes of this chapter, the term "aggregate
- 14 production operation" does not include:
- 15 (A) a site at which the materials that are being
- 16 removed or extracted from the earth are used or processed at the
- 17 same site or at a related site under the control of the same
- 18 responsible party for the production of cement or lightweight
- 19 aggregates, or in a lime kiln;
- 20 (B) a temporary site that is being used solely to
- 21 provide aggregate products for use in a public works project
- 22 involving the Texas Department of Transportation or a local
- 23 governmental entity;
- 24 (C) an extraction area from which all raw

- 1 material is extracted for use as fill or for other construction uses
- 2 at the same or a contiguous site; [or]
- 3 (D) a site at which the materials that are being
- 4 removed or extracted from the earth are used or processed for use in
- 5 the construction, modification, or expansion of a solid waste
- 6 facility at the site or another location; or
- 7 <u>(E) a site at which:</u>
- 8 <u>(i) the materials being removed or</u>
- 9 extracted from the earth are specialty or terrazo-type stone
- 10 removed or extracted exclusively for decorative or artistic uses;
- 11 and
- 12 <u>(ii)</u> the portion of the specialty or
- 13 terrazo-type stone horizon that is exposed for current production
- 14 for commercial sale in the site does not exceed five acres.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
