4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1302.002, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by amending Subdivision (5-a) and adding Subdivisions (11-b) and
7	(11-c) to read as follows:
8	(5-a) "Air conditioning and refrigeration technician"
9	and "air conditioning and refrigeration trainee" mean [means] a
10	person who assists a licensed air conditioning and refrigeration
11	contractor in performing air conditioning and refrigeration
12	maintenance work.
13	(11-b) "Licensed technician" means an air
14	conditioning and refrigeration technician who is licensed with the
15	department.
16	(11-c) "Licensed trainee" means an air conditioning
17	and refrigeration trainee who is licensed with the department.

- 22 license [registration] is valid throughout the state.
- 23 (c) A person is not required to obtain an air conditioning

- 25 only assists a licensed contractor in performing:
- 26 (1) the total replacement of a system; or
- 27 (2) the installation or repair of a boiler or pressure

- 1 vessel that must be installed in accordance with rules adopted
- 2 under Chapter 755, Health and Safety Code.
- 3 SECTION 7. The heading to Section 1302.503, Occupations
- 4 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1302.503. SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR <u>LICENSED</u>
- 6 TECHNICIANS [REGISTRANTS].
- 7 SECTION 8. Section 1302.5035, Occupations Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1302.5035. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS. (a) An
- 10 applicant for a technician <u>license</u> [registration] under this
- 11 subchapter must:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> be at least 18 years old; and
- 13 (2) have at least 12 months of practical experience in
- 14 air conditioning and refrigeration maintenance in the preceding 24
- 15 months under the supervision of a licensed air conditioning and
- 16 <u>refrigeration contractor</u>.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding the requirements of Subsection (a)(2),
- 18 an applicant may satisfy a portion of the practical experience
- 19 requirement as provided by Subsection (c).
- 20 <u>(c) An applicant who obtains a degree or diploma or</u>
- 21 completes a certification program from an institution of higher
- 22 education that holds a certificate of authority issued by the Texas
- 23 Higher Education Coordinating Board, or an equivalent governing
- 24 body in another state as approved by the executive director, may
- 25 satisfy a portion of the practical experience requirement as
- 26 follows:
- 27 (1) completing a four-year degree or diploma in air

- 1 conditioning engineering, refrigeration technology or engineering,
- 2 or mechanical engineering is equivalent to 24 months of practical
- 3 experience;
- 4 (2) completing a two-year associate's degree, a
- 5 two-year diploma, or a two-year certification program primarily
- 6 <u>focused on air conditioning and refrigeration-related work is</u>
- 7 equivalent to 12 months of practical experience; and
- 8 (3) completing a one-year certification program, or a
- 9 program of at least two semesters, in air conditioning and
- 10 refrigeration-related work is equivalent to six months of practical
- 11 experience.
- 12 (d) Every 2,000 hours of on-the-job training in an air
- 13 conditioning and refrigeration apprenticeship program registered
- 14 with the United States Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship
- 15 <u>is equivalent to 12 months of practical experience under Subsection</u>
- 16 <u>(a)(2)</u>.
- (e) Notwithstanding the requirements of Subsection (a)(2),
- 18 each of the following qualifies as practical experience for
- 19 purposes of satisfying the 12-month requirement:
- 20 (1) verified military service in which the person was
- 21 trained in or performed air conditioning and refrigeration-related
- 22 work as part of the person's military occupational specialty; and
- 23 (2) experience performing air conditioning and
- 24 refrigeration-related work that is:
- 25 (A) described by Section 1302.054, 1302.055,
- 26 1302.056, or 1302.057; and
- 27 (B) approved by the executive director. [An

- 1 applicant for a technician registration is not required to have
- 2 practical experience or to take an examination to obtain the
- 3 registration.
- 4 SECTION 9. Section 1302.504, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1302.504. APPLICATION; FEE. (a) An applicant for an
- 7 air conditioning and refrigeration technician <u>license</u>
- 8 [registration] must submit a verified application on a form
- 9 prescribed by the executive director.
- 10 (b) The completed application must be accompanied by:
- 11 (1) a statement containing evidence satisfactory to
- 12 the executive director of the applicant's practical experience; and
- 13 (2) the required fees.
- 14 SECTION 10. Subchapter K, Chapter 1302, Occupations Code,
- is amended by adding Section 1302.5045 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1302.5045. EXAMINATION. The executive director shall
- 17 prescribe an examination for an air conditioning and refrigeration
- 18 technician license, including the method, content, and compliance
- 19 requirements.
- 20 SECTION 11. Section 1302.505, Occupations Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1302.505. ISSUANCE AND TERM OF <u>TECHNICIAN LICENSE</u>
- 23 [REGISTRATION]. (a) The department shall issue an air
- 24 conditioning and refrigeration technician license [registration]
- 25 to an applicant who:
- 26 (1) submits a verified application;
- 27 (2) meets the requirements of this chapter and rules

- 1 adopted under this chapter; [and]
- 2 (3) passes the applicable examination; and
- 3 (4) pays the required fees.
- 4 (b) A <u>license</u> [registration] issued under this subchapter
- 5 is valid for one year from the date of issuance.
- 6 SECTION 12. Section 1302.506, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1302.506. TEMPORARY LICENSE [REGISTRATION]. (a) An
- 9 applicant for a license [registration] may request a temporary
- 10 <u>license</u> [registration]. The executive director shall issue a
- 11 temporary <u>license</u> [registration] that expires on the 21st day after
- 12 the date of issuance to an applicant who meets the qualifications
- 13 for a temporary license [registration].
- 14 (b) The commission shall adopt rules providing for the
- 15 issuance of a temporary <u>license</u> [registration] under this section,
- 16 including the qualifications and fee required for the <u>license</u>
- 17 [registration].
- 18 SECTION 13. Section 1302.508, Occupations Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1302.508. CERTIFIED TECHNICIAN. A licensed
- 21 [registered] technician may be certified by the department and use
- 22 the designation "certified technician" if the <u>licensed</u>
- 23 [registered] technician:
- 24 (1) completes an application for certification on a
- 25 form prescribed by the executive director;
- 26 (2) pays the application fee; and
- 27 (3) provides the department with proof that the

- 1 licensed [registered] technician successfully completed a
- 2 nationally recognized and administered certification examination
- 3 or another examination of equal or greater difficulty approved by
- 4 the department.
- 5 SECTION 14. Section 1302.509, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1302.509. PROHIBITED PRACTICES [LIMITATIONS ON
- 8 RECISTRANT]. A person licensed [registered] under this subchapter
- 9 may not:
- 10 (1) perform, offer to perform, or attempt to perform
- 11 an act that is:
- 12 (A) defined as the practice of engineering under
- 13 Chapter 1001, unless the person holds a license under that chapter;
- 14 (B) regulated under Chapter 113, Natural
- 15 Resources Code, unless the person holds a license under that
- 16 chapter or is exempt by a rule adopted under that chapter; or
- 17 (C) defined as plumbing under Chapter 1301,
- 18 unless the person holds a license under that chapter; or
- 19 (2) assist or work with a person who is not a licensed
- 20 air conditioning and refrigeration contractor in the performance of
- 21 air conditioning and refrigeration maintenance work.
- 22 SECTION 15. Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 23 adding Subchapter L to read as follows:
- 24 SUBCHAPTER L. AIR CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION TRAINEES
- Sec. 1302.551. LICENSE REQUIRED. (a) A person may not act
- 26 or offer to act as an air conditioning and refrigeration trainee
- 27 unless the person is licensed under this subchapter.

- 1 (b) An air conditioning and refrigeration trainee license
- 2 is valid throughout the state.
- 3 Sec. 1302.552. SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSED
- 4 TRAINEES. A licensed trainee must be supervised by an air
- 5 conditioning and refrigeration contractor licensed under this
- 6 chapter.
- 7 Sec. 1302.553. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS. (a) An applicant
- 8 for a trainee license under this subchapter must be at least 18
- 9 years old.
- 10 (b) An applicant for a trainee license is not required to
- 11 have practical experience or to take an examination to obtain the
- 12 license.
- Sec. 1302.554. APPLICATION; FEES. (a) An applicant for an
- 14 air conditioning and refrigeration trainee license must submit a
- 15 <u>verified application on a form prescribed by the executive</u>
- 16 <u>director</u>.
- 17 (b) The completed application must be accompanied by the
- 18 required fees.
- 19 Sec. 1302.555. ISSUANCE AND TERM OF TRAINEE LICENSE. (a)
- 20 The department shall issue an air conditioning and refrigeration
- 21 trainee license to an applicant who:
- 22 (1) submits a verified application on a form
- 23 prescribed by the executive director;
- 24 (2) meets the requirements of this chapter and rules
- 25 adopted under this chapter; and
- 26 (3) pays the required fees.
- 27 (b) A license issued under this subchapter is valid for one

- 1 year from the date of issuance.
- 2 Sec. 1302.556. TEMPORARY LICENSE. (a) An applicant for a
- 3 trainee license may request a temporary license. The executive
- 4 director shall issue a temporary license that expires on the 21st
- 5 day after the date of issuance to an applicant who meets the
- 6 qualifications for a temporary license.
- 7 (b) The commission shall adopt rules providing for the
- 8 issuance of a temporary license under this section, including the
- 9 qualifications and fee required for the license.
- 10 Sec. 1302.557. LIMITATIONS ON LICENSE HOLDER. A person
- 11 licensed under this subchapter may not:
- 12 (1) perform, offer to perform, or attempt to perform
- 13 an act that is:
- 14 (A) defined as the practice of engineering under
- 15 Chapter 1001, unless the person holds a license under that chapter;
- 16 (B) regulated under Chapter 113, Natural
- 17 Resources Code, unless the person holds a license under that
- 18 chapter or is exempt by a rule adopted under that chapter; or
- 19 (C) defined as plumbing under Chapter 1301,
- 20 unless the person holds a license under that chapter;
- 21 (2) assist a person who is not a licensed air
- 22 <u>conditioning and refrigeration contractor in the performance of air</u>
- 23 conditioning and refrigeration maintenance work; or
- 24 (3) work with a person or business entity that is not
- 25 an air conditioning and refrigeration contracting company
- 26 complying with Section 1302.252 in the performance of air
- 27 conditioning and refrigeration maintenance work.

- 1 SECTION 16. Section 1302.002(17), Occupations Code, is
- 2 repealed.
- 3 SECTION 17. (a) Not later than February 1, 2018, the Texas
- 4 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules to
- 5 implement the changes in law made by this Act to Chapter 1302,
- 6 Occupations Code.
- 7 (b) The Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall
- 8 adopt rules to convert and renew an air conditioning and
- 9 refrigeration registration issued before March 1, 2018, to an air
- 10 conditioning and refrigeration technician license without imposing
- 11 the additional eligibility requirements under Chapter 1302,
- 12 Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
- 13 (c) Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act,
- 14 applies only to an application for a license under that chapter
- 15 submitted to the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation on or
- 16 after March 1, 2018. An application for a license, registration, or
- 17 certification submitted under that chapter before that date is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was
- 19 submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose.
- 21 SECTION 18. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of
- 22 this section, this Act takes effect March 1, 2018.
- 23 (b) Section 17 of this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
