## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the appointment of an attorney general liaison for each
- 3 regional office of the Department of Family and Protective
- 4 Services.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 402, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 402.040 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 402.040. CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES LIAISON. For each
- 9 regional office of the Department of Family and Protective Services
- 10 that provides child protective services, the attorney general shall
- 11 appoint an employee to serve as a liaison to the department for that
- 12 <u>regional office. The liaison shall:</u>
- (1) serve as a point of contact for the attorney
- 14 general's office to increase communication between the regional
- 15 office and the attorney general's office;
- 16 (2) provide assistance to the regional office in
- 17 locating absent parents of children in the managing conservatorship
- 18 of the department; and
- 19 (3) provide to the regional office information in the
- 20 attorney general's child support database that will enable the
- 21 regional office to locate absent parents of children in the
- 22 managing conservatorship of the department.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
