9 SECTION 6. (a) The changes in law made by this Act do not 10 affect the validity of a proceeding pending before a court or other 11 governmental entity on the effective date of this Act.

(b) An offense or other violation of law committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense or violation was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this subsection, an offense or violation was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense or violation occurred before that date.

19 SECTION 7. (a) Sections 2308.153(c), 2308.154(c), and 20 2308.155(c), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, apply to a 21 license issued or renewed before, on, or after the effective date of 22 this Act.

(b) A license issued under Section 2303.1016 or 2308.1521, Occupations Code, that is unexpired or eligible for renewal by the license holder on the effective date of this Act expires on the earlier of:

(1) the expiration date stated on the license; or
