## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to including in the minimum attendance requirement of a
- 3 public school student any absence of the student to participate in
- 4 an extracurricular activity.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 25.092, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (a-3) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-3)</u> In determining if a student has complied with
- 9 <u>attendance requirements under Subsection (a)</u>, the school district
- 10 may not include any absence of a student from class if the student
- 11 <u>is absent to attend an extracurricular activity.</u> In this
- 12 <u>subsection "extracurricular activity" means a voluntary activity</u>
- 13 sponsored by the school district and includes preparation for and
- 14 involvement in public performances, contests, athletic
- 15 competitions, demonstrations, displays, and club activities.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
