Sections 401.208(a), (c), and (e), Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 At least once every four years, the [The] commission 7 (a) shall conduct a study on the available volume and curie capacity of 8 9 the compact waste disposal facility for the disposal of party state 10 compact waste and nonparty compact waste. The [Not later than December 1, 2016, the] commission 11 (C) 12 shall submit a final report of the results of the study to the standing committees of the senate and the house of representatives 13 14 with jurisdiction over the disposal of low-level radioactive waste. (e) The commission may conduct a study described by 15 Subsection (a) at any time [after December 1, 2012,] if the 16 commission determines that a study is necessary. 17 18 SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall submit the first report required under Section 401.208, 19 Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, not later than 20 21 December 1, 2020. 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24
