1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to exempting certain persons from a fee for replacement
 1-20 registration insignia and license plates.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 502.060(b), Transportation Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (b) No fee is required under this section if:

1-25 (1) the replacement fee for a license plate has been
 1-26 paid under Section 504.007; or

1-27 (2) a county assessor-collector determines that the
 1-28 owner of a registered motor vehicle did not receive a registration
 1-29 insignia that was issued to the owner by mail.

1-30 SECTION 2. Section 504.007, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-31 by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

1-32 (g) No fee is required under this section if a county
 1-33 assessor-collector determines that the owner of a registered motor
 1-34 vehicle did not receive license plates that were issued to the owner
 1-35 by mail.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
