4	SECTION 1. Subchapter LL, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
5	amended by amending Section 2306.933 and adding Sections 2306.934
6	and 2306.935 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2306.933. CIVIL PENALTY. (a) A person who violates
8	this subchapter or a rule adopted under this subchapter is subject
9	to a civil penalty of not less than \$50 for each person occupying
10	the migrant labor housing facility in violation of this subchapter
11	[\$200] for each day that the violation occurs.
12	(b) An [The county attorney for the county in which the
13	violation occurred, or the attorney general, at the request of the
14	department, shall bring an] action [in the name of the state] to

 collect a [the] penalty under this section may be brought by:

 (1) the department through the contested case hearing

- 4 (d) A penalty collected under Subsection (b)(1) or (2) shall
- 5 be deposited to the credit of the general revenue fund and may be

- 8 Sec. 2306.934. RETALIATION PROHIBITED. A person who owns,
- 9 establishes, maintains, operates, or otherwise provides a migrant
- 10 labor housing facility, a person who employs a migrant agricultural
- 11 worker who occupies a migrant labor housing facility, or a farm
- 12 labor contractor may not retaliate against a person for filing a
- 13 complaint or providing information in good faith relating to a
- 14 possible violation of this subchapter.
- Sec. 2306.935. ATTORNEY'S FEES. The court in a suit brought
- 16 under this subchapter may award reasonable attorney's fees to the
- 17 prevailing party.
- 18 SECTION 2. Not later than March 1, 2018, the Texas
- 19 Department of Housing and Community Affairs shall adopt the rules
- 20 necessary to implement Subchapter LL, Chapter 2306, Government
- 21 Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act in amending
- 23 Section 2306.933, Government Code, and adding Section 2306.935,
- 24 Government Code, applies only to a violation that occurs on or after
- 25 the effective date of this Act. A violation that occurs before the
- 26 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 27 date the violation occurred, and the former law is continued in

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- 1 effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, a violation
- 2 occurs before the effective date of this Act if any element of the
- 3 violation occurs before that date.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
