- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) In this Act, "bilingual zone" means a
- 6 designated area of this state in which:
- 7 (1) English and Spanish are both official languages;
- 8 (2) residents have the right to receive services from
- 9 state and local governmental entities in both official languages;
- 10 (3) residents may be heard before the state court
- 11 system in the official language of their choice;
- 12 (4) state and local laws are published in both
- 13 official languages and given equal legal weight; and
- 14 (5) both official languages have equal status in state
- 15 and local governmental employment.
- 16 (b) The comptroller of public accounts, in cooperation with
- 17 the secretary of state, the B3 Institute at The University of Texas
- 18 Rio Grande Valley, and other interested parties, shall conduct a
- 19 study to evaluate the creation of bilingual zones in certain areas
- 20 of this state.
- 21 (c) In conducting the study, the comptroller shall:
- 22 (1) identify and evaluate areas of this state along
- 23 the border with the United Mexican States that may be designated
- 24 bilingual zones;

- 1 (2) assess the impact the creation and operation of
- 2 bilingual zones would have on this state's economy; and
- 3 (3) evaluate the effect the creation and operation of
- 4 bilingual zones would have on border and international relations.
- 5 (d) Not later than September 1, 2018, the comptroller shall
- 6 prepare and submit to the legislature a written report containing
- 7 the results of the study and any recommendations for legislative or
- 8 other action.
- 9 (e) This Act expires September 1, 2019.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
