## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 552.0222 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.0222. DATE OF BIRTH. A date of birth is public
- 8 information and not excepted from required disclosure unless made
- 9 confidential under this chapter or other law.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 552.102, Government Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 12 (c) This section does not exempt from disclosure a date of
- 13 birth.
- 14 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 15 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 16 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
