A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to overtime pay for child protective services employees in the Department of Family and Protective Services. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 40, Human Resources Code, is amended by adding Section 40.03211 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 40.03211. OVERTIME PAY FOR CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES PERSONNEL. The department may not authorize child protective 8 9 services employees to work overtime hours unless the department has sufficient funds to fully compensate employees for the total number 10 11 of hours worked during each pay period. The department may not delay 12 compensation to child protective services employees for overtime hours worked during a pay period. 13 14 SECTION 2. Immediately after the effective date of this

Act, using funds appropriated to the Department of Family and Protective Services for the 2018-2019 fiscal biennium for the purpose of employee compensation, the department shall reimburse department employees who have previously worked overtime hours and are owed compensation for those hours by the department as of the effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
