SECTION 2. Section 133.003, Local Government Code, 6 is 7 amended to read as follows: 8 Sec. 133.003. CRIMINAL FEES. This chapter applies to the following criminal fees: 9 10 (1)the consolidated fee imposed under Section 133.102; 11 12 (2) [the time payment fee imposed under Section 133.103; 13 14 [(3)] fees for services of peace officers employed by 15 the state imposed under Article 102.011, Code of Criminal Procedure, and forwarded to the comptroller as provided by Section 16 133.104; 17 (3) [(4)] costs on conviction imposed in 18 certain 19 statutory county courts under Section 51.702, Government Code, and deposited in the judicial fund; 20 21 (4) [(5)] costs on conviction imposed in certain county courts under Section 51.703, Government Code, and deposited 22 23 in the judicial fund; 24 (5) [(6)] the administrative fee for failure to appear or failure to pay or satisfy a judgment imposed under Section 25 26 706.006, Transportation Code; 27 (6) [(7)] fines on conviction imposed under Section

8 SECTION 3. Section 133.103, Local Government Code, is 9 repealed.

SECTION 4. The repeal by this Act of Section 133.103, Local 10 Government Code, does not apply to an offense committed before the 11 effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the 12 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed on 13 the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued 14 15 in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any 16 element of the offense occurred before that date. 17
