H.B. No. 2778

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to permits for oversize and overweight vehicles in a
3 certain county.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 623.252(b), Transportation Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b) A permit issued under this subchapter may authorize:

8 (1) the transport of cargo only on the following roads
9 in Chambers County:

10 (A) Farm-to-Market Road 1405 between its
11 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 2354 and its intersection
12 with Farm-to-Market Road 565;

13 (B) ~~[the frontage road of]~~ State Highway 99,
14 including the frontage road of State Highway 99 and the portion of
15 the frontage road located in the Cedar Crossing Business and
16 Industrial Park, other than a tolled segment of State Highway 99,
17 between the [its] crossing of State Highway 99 with Cedar Bayou and
18 its intersection with Interstate Highway 10~~[, including the portion~~
19 ~~of the frontage road located in the Cedar Crossing Business and~~
20 ~~Industrial Park]~~;

21 (C) Farm-to-Market Road 565 from its
22 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 to its intersection with
23 State Highway 99; and

24 (D) Farm-to-Market Road 2354 from its

1 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1405 northwest approximately
2 300 linear feet to the termination of the state-maintained portion
3 of the road; and

4 (2) the movement of equipment and commodities weighing
5 100,000 pounds or less.

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
