4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 821.023(e), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(e) After a court finds that an animal's owner has cruelly
8	treated the animal, the court shall order the owner to pay all
9	[court] costs <u>to the appropriate party</u> , including:
10	(1) the administrative costs of:
11	(A) investigation;
12	(B) expert witnesses; and
13	(C) conducting any public sale ordered by the
14	court; [and]
15	(2) the costs incurred by a municipal or county animal
16	shelter or a nonprofit animal welfare organization in:
17	(A) housing and caring for the animal during its
18	<pre>impoundment; and</pre>
19	(B) humanely destroying the animal if
20	destruction is ordered by the court; and
21	(3) any costs incurred by a landlord or landowner in
22	housing and caring for an animal unreasonably abandoned by a tenant
23	after the tenant's eviction.
24	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to

costs incurred by a landlord or landowner on or after the effective
date of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
