- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 547.305, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (e-1) and (e-2) and amending Subsection (f)
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (e-1) A security patrol vehicle may only be equipped with
- 9 green, amber, or white lights.
- 10 (e-2) A motor vehicle is equipped with a lamp or
- 11 <u>illuminating device under this section regardless of whether the</u>
- 12 <u>lamp or illuminating device is:</u>
- 13 (1) attached to the motor vehicle temporarily or
- 14 permanently; or
- 15 <u>(2) activated.</u>
- 16 (f) In this section:
- 17 (1) "Security patrol vehicle" means a motor vehicle
- 18 being used for the purpose of providing security services by:
- 19 <u>(A) a guard company described by Section</u>
- 20 <u>1702.108</u>, Occupations Code; or
- 21 (B) a security officer as defined by Section
- 22 1702.002, Occupations Code.
- 23 (2) "Tow ["tow"] truck" means a motor vehicle or
- 24 mechanical device that is adapted or used to tow, winch, or move a

- 1 disabled vehicle.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2018.
