- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.03, Penal Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (k) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (f) and (h), an
- 10 offense under this section is:
- 11 (1) a Class C misdemeanor if:
- 12 (A) the amount of pecuniary loss is less than
- 13 \$100; or
- 14 (B) except as provided in Subdivision (3)(A) or
- 15 (3)(B), it causes substantial inconvenience to others;
- 16 (2) a Class B misdemeanor if the amount of pecuniary
- 17 loss is \$100 or more but less than \$750;
- 18 (3) a Class A misdemeanor if:
- 19 (A) the amount of pecuniary loss is \$750 or more
- 20 but less than \$2,500; or
- (B) the actor causes in whole or in part

- 3 (4) a state jail felony if the amount of pecuniary loss

- 7 destroyed is a habitation and if the damage or destruction is caused
- 8 by a firearm or explosive weapon;

- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 11 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 12 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 13 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 14 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 15 before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
