Section 16.031, Election Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows: 6 7 (c) A registrar commits an offense if the registrar fails to comply with Subsection (a)(2) or (b). 8 9 (d) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor. SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 10 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An 11 12 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the 13 14 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 15 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
