## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the procedures for removing certain persons' names from 3 the child abuse and neglect central registry.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 261.002(b), Family Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary8 to carry out this section. The rules shall:

9 (1) prohibit the department from making a finding of 10 abuse or neglect against a person in a case in which the department 11 is named managing conservator of a child who has a severe emotional 12 disturbance only because the child's family is unable to obtain 13 mental health services for the child; [and]

14 (2) establish guidelines for reviewing the records in 15 the registry and removing those records in which the department was 16 named managing conservator of a child who has a severe emotional 17 disturbance only because the child's family was unable to obtain 18 mental health services for the child<u>;</u>

19 <u>(3) require the department to remove a person's name</u> 20 <u>from the central registry maintained under this section not later</u> 21 <u>than the 10th business day after the date the department receives</u> 22 <u>notice that a finding of abuse and neglect against the person is</u> 23 <u>overturned in:</u>
