If the court dismisses a suit affecting the parent-child 9 relationship filed under this chapter on the basis that 10 insufficient evidence exists to satisfy a person of ordinary 11 12 prudence and caution that the parent abused or neglected the child, the department may not include a reason to believe finding against 13 14 the parent in the department's records for the case. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 15
