4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 37.125, Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 37.125. EXHIBITION, USE, OR THREAT OF EXHIBITION OR

- 8 <u>USE OF FIREARMS</u>. (a) A person commits an offense if, in a manner
- 9 intended to cause alarm or personal injury to another person or to
- 10 damage school property, the person intentionally:
- 11 (1) exhibits or [7] uses[7 or threatens to exhibit or
- 12 use] a firearm:
- 13 $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ [\(\frac{\((1)\)}{\(1)\)}] in or on any property, including a
- 14 parking lot, parking garage, or other parking area, that is owned by
- 15 a private or public school; or
- 16 $\underline{\text{(B)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$] on a school bus being used to transport
- 17 children to or from school-sponsored activities of a private or
- 18 public school;
- (2) threatens to exhibit or use a firearm in or on
- 20 property described by Subdivision (1)(A) or on a bus described by
- 21 Subdivision (1)(B) and was in possession of or had immediate access
- 22 to the firearm; or
- 23 (3) threatens to exhibit or use a firearm in or on
- 24 property described by Subdivision (1)(A) or on a bus described by

- 1 <u>Subdivision (1)(B)</u>.
- 2 (b) An offense under <u>Subsection (a)(1) or (2)</u> [this section]
- 3 is a third degree felony.
- 4 (c) An offense under Subsection (a)(3) is a Class A
- 5 misdemeanor.
- 6 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 7 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 8 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 9 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 10 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 11 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 12 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
