A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to reimbursement rates for certain therapy services under
- 3 Medicaid and accountability to Medicaid recipients.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 531.021, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (h) In adopting rates for Medicaid payments under
- 8 Subsection (b-1), the executive commissioner shall ensure that
- 9 reimbursement rates for occupational, physical, and speech therapy
- 10 services provided to recipients are at least equal to the
- 11 reimbursement rates for occupational, physical, and speech therapy
- 12 <u>services in effect on August 31, 2015, regardless of whether the</u>
- 13 <u>reimbursements are paid through a fee for service system or a</u>
- 14 managed care system. The executive commissioner shall adopt rules
- 15 to ensure the accountability of the commission to recipients who
- 16 are dependent on those therapy services.
- 17 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 18 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 19 Services Commission shall adopt the rules required by Section
- 20 531.021(h), Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 22 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 23 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 24 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

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- 1 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 2 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
