- 8 <u>ELECTRONIC MAIL MESSAGES PROHIBITED AFTER REQUEST FOR REMOVAL. A</u>
- 9 sender or a person acting on behalf of a sender may not transmit an
- 10 <u>unsolicited commercial electronic mail message to the electronic</u>
- 11 mail address of a person who requests the removal of that address
- 12 from the sender's electronic mail list as provided by Section
- 13 <u>321.052(a)(2).</u>
