2	relating to the licensing and regulation of military optometrists
3	and therapeutic optometrists who provide voluntary charity care.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 351, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 351.266 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 351.266. MILITARY LIMITED VOLUNTEER LICENSE. (a) The
8	board shall adopt rules relating to the issuance of a military
9	limited volunteer license under this section.
10	(b) The board may issue a military limited volunteer license
11	to practice optometry or therapeutic optometry to an applicant who:
12	(1) is licensed and in good standing, or was licensed
13	and retired in good standing, as an optometrist or therapeutic
14	<pre>optometrist in another state;</pre>
15	(2) is or was authorized as an optometrist or
16	therapeutic optometrist to treat personnel enlisted in a branch of
17	the United States armed forces or veterans; and
18	(3) meets any other requirement prescribed by board
19	rule.
20	(c) The board may not issue a license under this section to
21	an applicant who:
22	(1) holds an optometry or therapeutic optometry
23	license that:
24	(A) is currently under active investigation; or

(B) is or was subject to a disciplinary order or 1 2 action or to denial by another jurisdiction; (2) holds a license to prescribe, dispense, 3 administer, supply, or sell a controlled substance that: 4 5 (A) is currently under active investigation; or 6 (B) is or was subject to a disciplinary order or action or to denial by another jurisdiction; or 7 8 (3) has been convicted of, is on deferred adjudication community supervision or deferred disposition for, or is under 9 active investigation for the commission of: 10 11 (A) a felony; or (B) a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. 12 (d) An optometrist or therapeutic optometrist may practice 13 14 optometry or therapeutic optometry under a license issued under 15 this section only at a clinic that primarily treats indigent patients. The optometrist or therapeutic optometrist may not 16 17 directly or indirectly receive compensation or anything of monetary value for optometric services rendered at the clinic. 18 19 (e) A military limited volunteer license holder is subject to board rules, including rules regarding disciplinary action, 20 21 license registration and renewal, and continuing medical 22 education.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
