The commissioner shall by rule adopt network adequacy standards that: 8 9 (1)are adapted to local markets in which an insurer offering a preferred provider benefit plan operates; 10 11 (2) ensure availability of, and accessibility to, a full range of contracted physicians and health care providers to 12 provide health care services to insureds; [and] 13 14 (3) on good cause shown, may allow departure from local market network adequacy standards if the commissioner posts 15 on the department's Internet website the name of the preferred 16 provider plan, the insurer offering the plan, and the affected 17 local market; and 18 (4) hold insurers accountable for the networks the 19 insurers utilize and for any departure from network adequacy 20 standards. 21 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
