## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a temporary moratorium on permits for municipal solid
- 3 waste facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. In this Act:
- 6 (1) "Commission" means the Texas Commission or
- 7 Environmental Quality.
- 8 (2) "Solid waste facility" has the meaning assigned by
- 9 Section 361.003, Health and Safety Code.
- 10 SECTION 2. (a) Until September 1, 2019, the commission may
- 11 not accept an application for or issue a permit, permit amendment,
- 12 license, or other authorization for or in connection with a new
- 13 solid waste facility.
- 14 (b) This section applies to the issuance of a permit, permit
- 15 amendment, license, or other authorization regardless of whether
- 16 the application for the authorization is pending on the effective
- 17 date of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. (a) The commission shall conduct a study
- 19 assessing the safety and regulation of solid waste facilities in
- 20 this state. The study must consider:
- 21 (1) the permit application and approval process;
- 22 (2) restrictions regarding the location of solid waste
- 23 facilities;
- 24 (3) inspections and enforcement of regulations

- 1 regarding solid waste facilities; and
- 2 (4) any other matters the commission considers
- 3 appropriate.
- 4 (b) Not later than September 1, 2018, the commission shall
- 5 provide to each standing committee of the legislature with primary
- 6 jurisdiction over environmental regulation a detailed written
- 7 report regarding the study conducted under this section.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
