17	holds a dealer license and bond, if applicable, issued by the other			
18	state and the transaction is not intended to avoid a requirement of			
19	this chapter; or			
20	(2) buying, selling, including by consignment, or			
21	exchanging at a public auction:			
22	(A) an antique vehicle that is at least 25 years
